



The Salt House is a rare example of a contemporary UK sea-side house. Described by The Guardian's Architecture critic Jonathan Glancey as "one of the best new houses in Britain today", the building has been hailed as a prototype for flood-proof residential construction and reinvents the Modernist tradition of the 'experimental' beach house.

In 2006 the project won the Grand Designs Award for the Best New Build House of the Year and in 2008 was awarded the 2007 RIBA Manser Medal.
