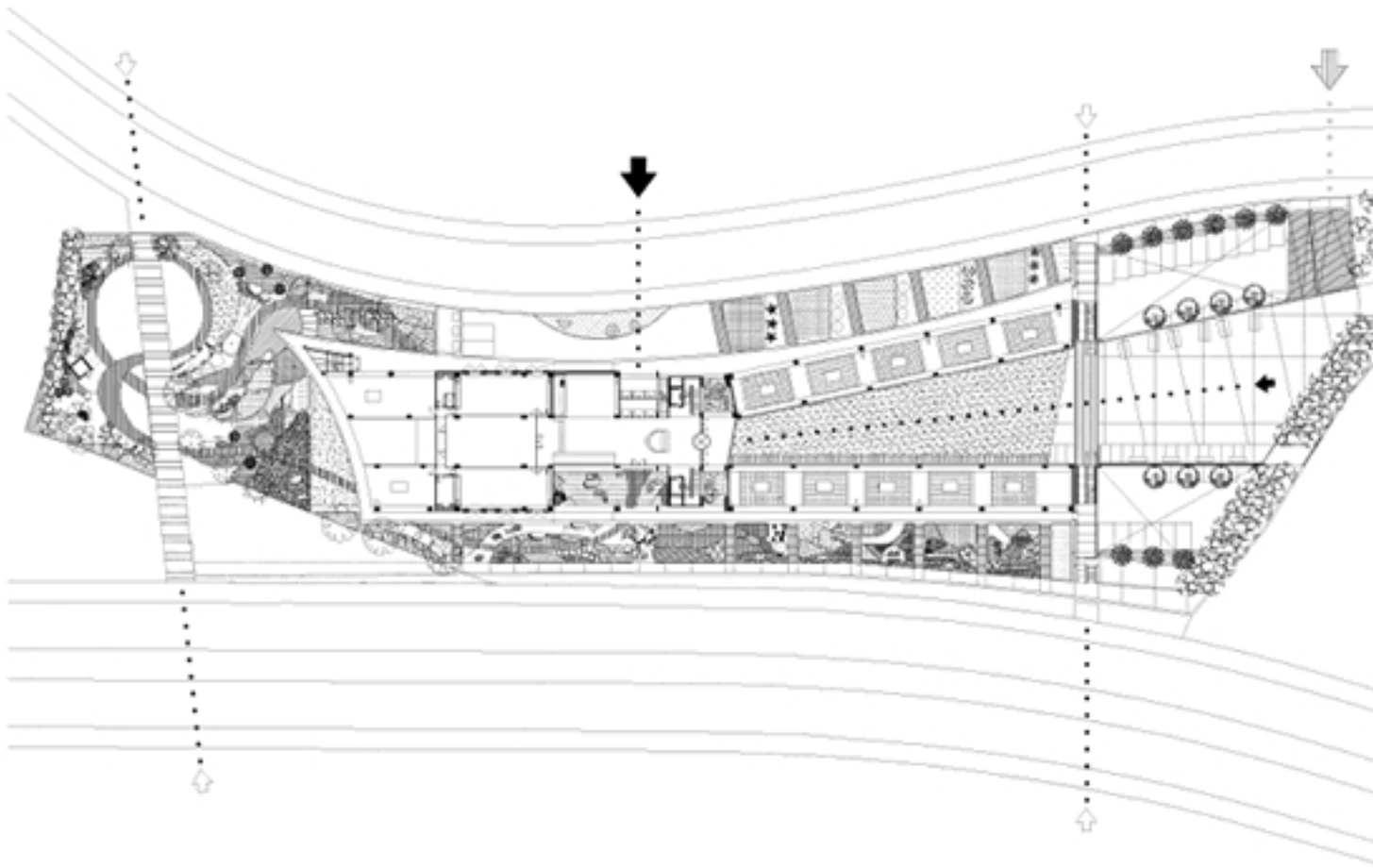


The project hosts the offices of the Cyprus Olympic Committee and of all the National Athletic Federations.



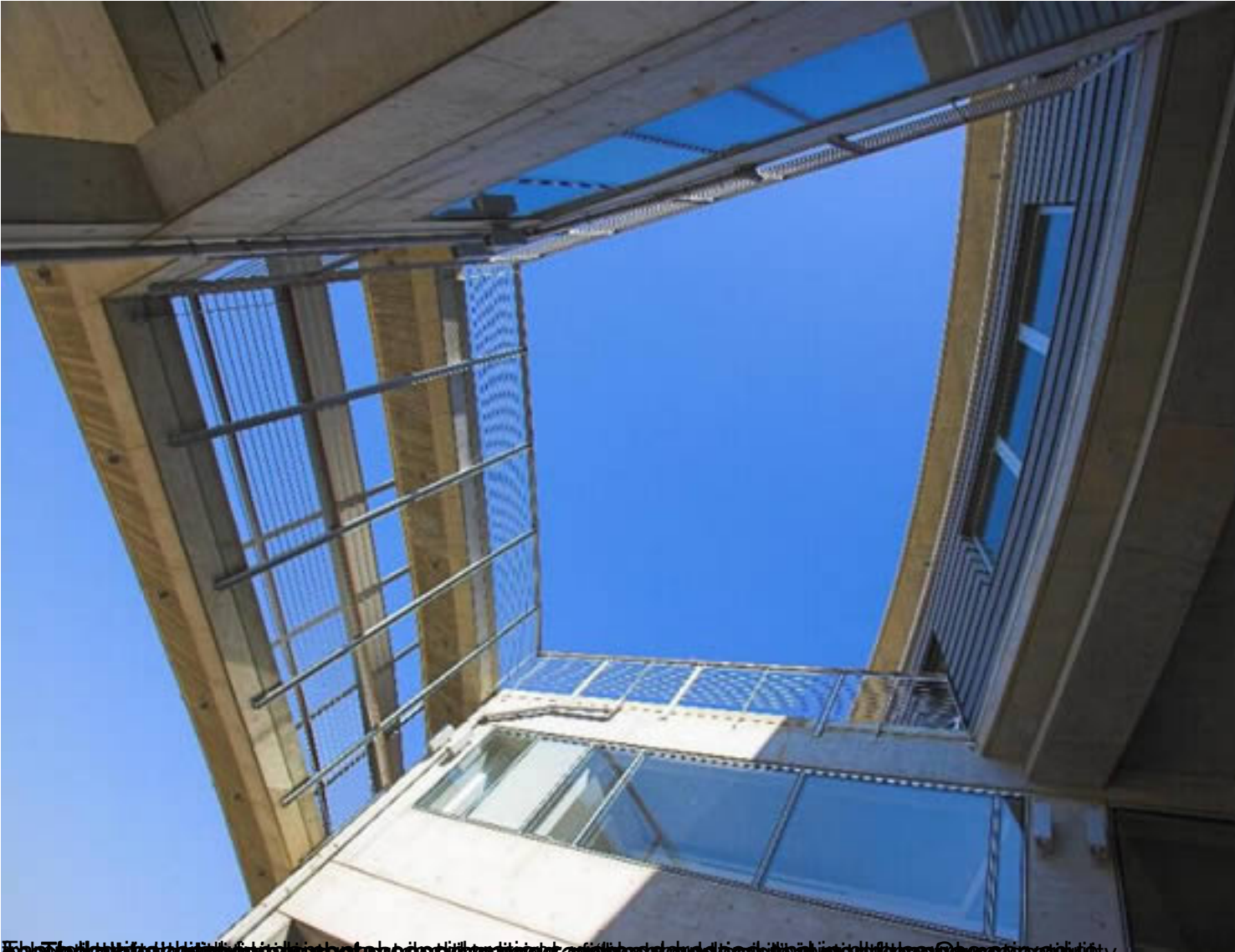
