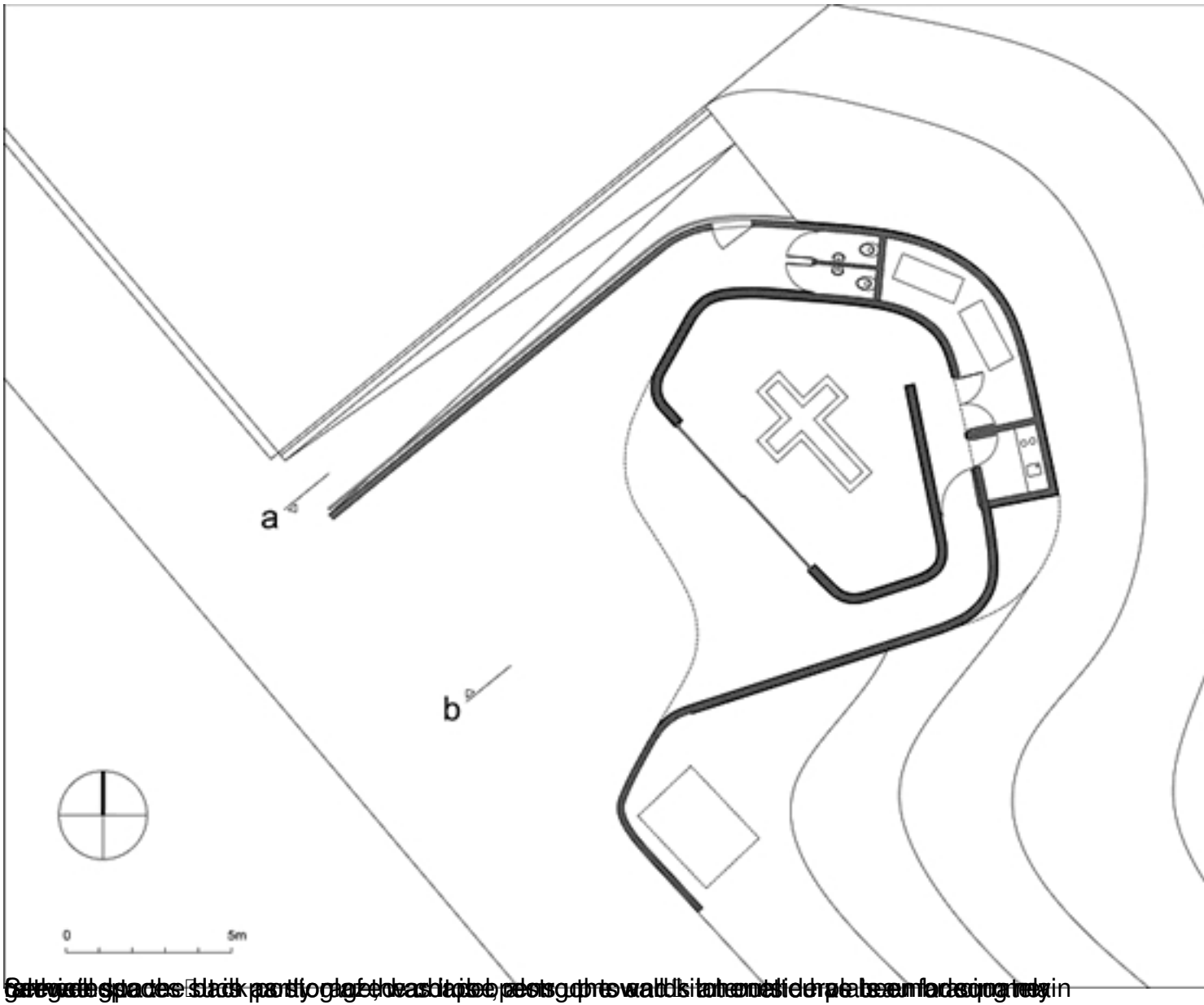








Because of the curved walls and the landscaped roof, integrates the Chapel into the hill of the
