Lake|Flato, won the competition with a design proposal that included "a unique blend of



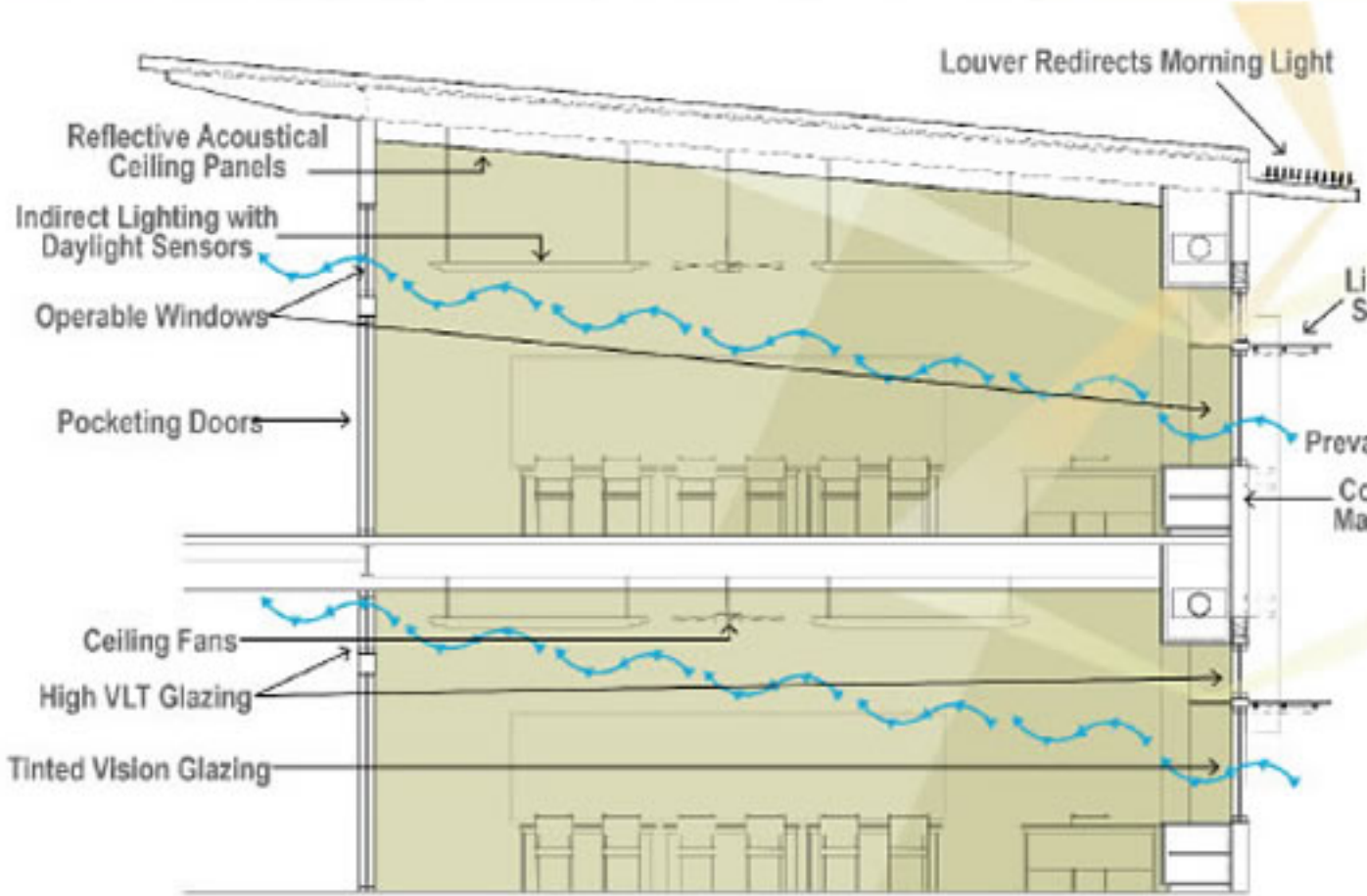

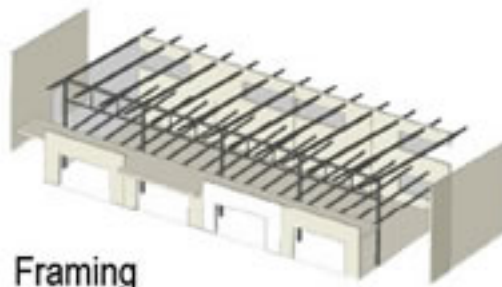




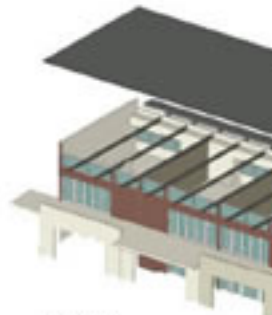
