

Yale University Arts Complex Awarded LEED Gold and the Burchfield Penney Art Center at Buffalo State College Receives a LEED Silver Certification.



The completely renovated and expanded **Paul Rudolph Hall** at Yale University, designed by Gwathmey Siegel & Associates Architects (GSAA) has received a LEED Gold certification. The 114,000 square foot building, constructed of cast-in-place concrete in the Brutalist style, was formerly known as the Art and Architecture Building. It was designed by then chair of the Department of Architecture, Paul Rudolph and completed in 1963.
