



The overarching concept for this 2,900-square-foot beach-side modern house was to transform it into an urban spa-like retreat. The house is perched along Malibu's Pacific Coast Highway, and features access to beach in the back. A transitional interior entry courtyard, laid with rectangular cement pavers and bordered by smooth river rock and tufted grasses, introduces the primary design element of the home—a seamless union between interior and exterior spaces, with crisp linear architecture, ambulating plan, and visual access throughout.

From the entry courtyard, an original space accented by a white grid of window panes houses dining room. The graphic grid is echoed by geometric pattern of the cabinets and shelves that

lead into the minimal kitchen. True to the open plan, the kitchen seamlessly overlooks the main living space.

The interior design palette of natural woods and limestone, white walls and fabrics, frosted and clear plate-glass creates a crisp and airy environment to appreciate the Pacific Ocean setting.
