

Casa Viguet is a 70 m² (750 sq ft), intentionally minimalist, single room house located in Pilar - Buenos Aires. The architect, Nicolás Del Campo, placed the house in the center of the much larger, 1,500 m² (16,100 Sq ft), naturally landscaped site, generating multiple gardens for the user to enjoy. The house becomes a synergy between the monolithic interior and the multi-faceted exterior.
