

Casa Viguet is a 70 m<sup>2</sup> (750 sq ft), intentionally minimalist, single room house located in Pilar - Buenos Aires. The architect, Nicolás Del Campo, placed the house in the center of the much larger, 1,500 m<sup>2</sup> (16,100 Sq ft), naturally landscaped site, generating multiple gardens for the user to enjoy. The house becomes a synergy between the monolithic interior and the multi-faceted exterior.





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As expected, the kitchen has a clean, minimalist aesthetic. The circular openings in the window are a unique design element, and the white table and chairs provide a simple, functional seating area. The wooden ceiling adds a touch of warmth to the otherwise white space.
